Early Arrivers

With the success of the Morning Drop-and-Go system, we have noticed an increase in the number of students arriving early. To maintain appropriate supervision, we have introduced a new arrangement for students arriving between 7:00 to 7:30 am. All early arrivers must enter through Gate 1.

Grades 1 to 11: These students must go straight to the canteen where they can buy breakfast and engage in quiet activities, such as chatting, drawing or coloring. Please note that digital devices are not permitted during this time, as it is intended for social interaction.

MYP/DP Coffee & Connect: 19th September

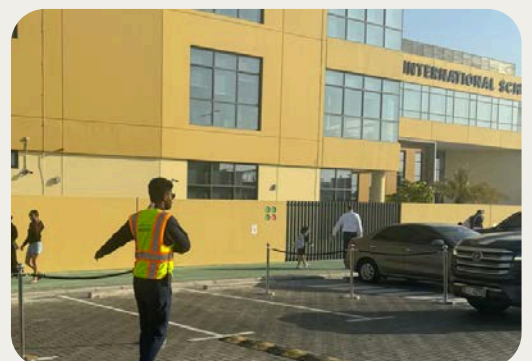

Whilst this session is geared towards parents new to the IB, returning parents are also welcome. We will adapt and ensure we extend your knowledge.

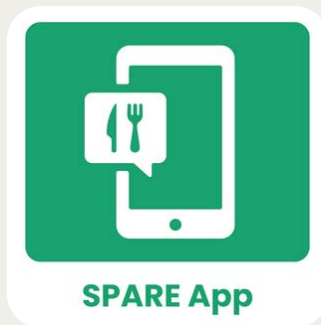
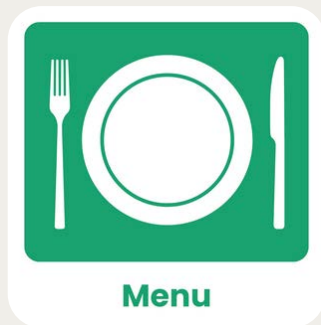
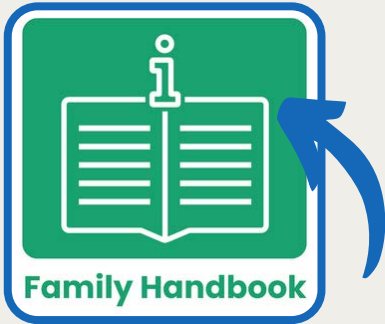
