- 2. Lanyards** All parents and guardians, including nannies, must wear a lanyard at all times when on school grounds. If you forget your lanyard, please see security for a visitor lanyard from Gates 1, 2, 4 or 5.
- 3. School Uniforms** Uniforms are a key part of our school community. They help students develop pride in their school and reinforce the importance of being principled and caring, in line with the IB Learner Profile. Uniforms may be purchased at Magrudy's in the Forsan Central Mall or at our KCC Second Hand Uniform Shop on the first floor above the main reception, contact kccshus@ris.ae for timings.
- 4. Attendance & Punctuality** Regular attendance and punctuality are essential for success. If your child is absent or late, please make sure to update Toddle under the 'Attendance' section. Absences are only authorised according to ADEK policy.

- 6. Canteen Updates** We've introduced a new canteen layout to improve traffic flow and serving times, added plants to reduce noise, set up drinking water and student cleaning stations, and encourage using the SPARE app to pre-order meals. Please also remember that we are a nut-free school.
