Uniform Policy

The school uniform is to be worn during each school day unless special activity days are announced. Students are expected to wear the uniform to and from school. We encourage our students to take pride in their uniforms as a reflection of their pride in the School. Clothes worn underneath the shirts must be plain white, black or natural-coloured.

School uniform clothing must be purchased from Magrudy's.

Early Years (Minis to EY2)

- Minis will wear Raha KCC PE uniform
- Early Years 1 & 2 students will wear green Raha polo T-shirts.
- Raha shorts and skorts for Early Years 1 & 2 students are grey with red piping, and Early Years students may wear the grey trousers.
- School Hoodies must be the Raha Hoodies.
- Girls may wear leggings under skorts. These should be plain and compliment the uniform colours (white, dark grey or black).
- Socks must be solid black or white.
- Standard school uniform must be worn at all times except on PE days.
- Jewellery should be minimal and plain (no dangling earrings).
- Hats must be removed inside the buildings, excluding shaylas.
- Early Years students are not permitted to wear makeup.

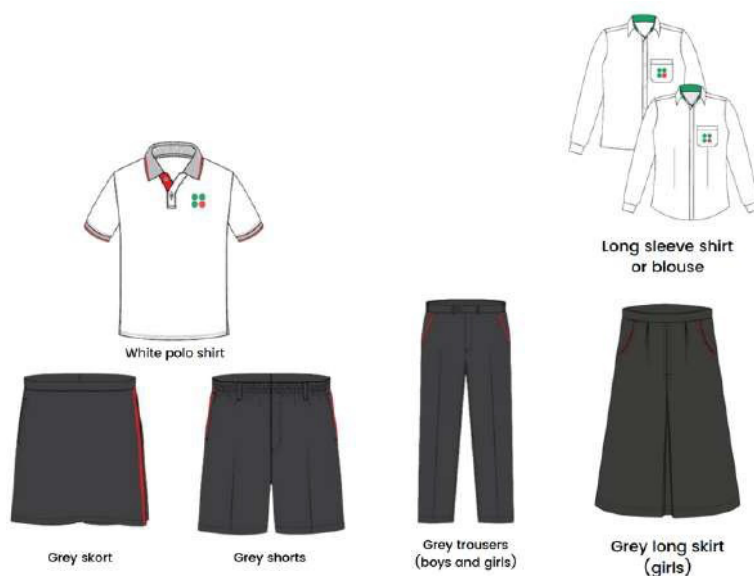
Swimming Uniform

- Swim caps are an expectation for all students.
- School issue swimsuits are not compulsory but are available.
- Students must bring their own towel, goggles, and swim cap in a drawstring bag.
- See below for guidance on swimwear and footwear on swimming days:

	<p>A two-piece suit like this can be worn to school instead of uniform.</p> <p>Please put your child's underwear and uniform in their bag for after swimming.</p>		<p>Shorts like this must be worn underneath the full school uniform.</p>
	<p>Shorts like this can be worn to school instead of school shorts.</p> <p>The rest of the uniform must be worn to school.</p>		<p>These shoes may be worn to and from school only on swimming days.</p>
	<p>A swimsuit like this must be worn underneath the full school uniform.</p>		<p>These shoes must only be worn at the pool.</p> <p>Please send your child to school in normal school shoes.</p>

Primary (Grades 1-5)

- Primary students will wear white Raha polo shirts.
- Raha shorts and skorts for Primary students are grey with red piping.
- Primary students may wear the grey trousers.
- Girls may wear leggings under skorts. These should be plain and compliment the uniform colours (white, dark grey or black).
- School Hoodies must be the Raha Hoodies.
- Standard school uniform must be worn at all times except on PE days.
- Jewellery should be minimal and plain (no dangling earrings).
- Primary students are not permitted to wear makeup.
- Hats must be removed inside the buildings.

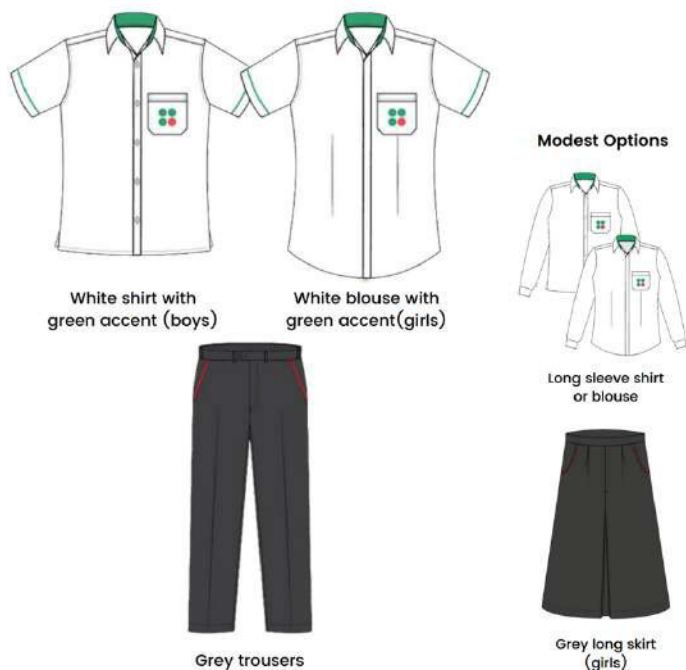


Swimming Uniform

- Swim caps are an expectation for all students.
- Girls' swimsuit must be one piece only.
- Swim-shorts with a waist drawstring for boys.
- It is recommended that students have their own pair of goggles for swimming.
- School issue swimsuits are not compulsory but are available.

Secondary (Grades 6-10)

- Secondary students will wear white Raha shirts with green bands.
- Raha trousers for Secondary students are grey with red piping.
- Uniform shirts are to be worn at all times, even under jumpers, sweaters and sweatshirts.
- School Hoodies must be the Raha Hoodies.
- Long sleeve shirts can be worn under shirt and can be white or black.
- Standard school uniform must be worn at all times except on PE days.
- Jewellery should be minimal and plain (no dangling earrings)
- Hats must be removed inside the buildings.
- Make-up can only be mascara and clear lip gloss.



Swimming Uniform

- Girls' swimsuit must be one piece only.
- Swim-shorts with a waist drawstring for boys.
- Swim caps are an expectation for all students.
- School issue swimsuits are not compulsory but are available.
- It is recommended that students have their own pair of goggles.

Footwear for Standard Uniform – EY / Primary / Secondary

- Shoes must be closed toe, must be shoes. There is no requirement for colour.

Hats

- All children in EY and Primary require a hat for outside playtime, to protect the face from over-exposure to sunshine, as per our 'No hat, no play' policy.
- There is no requirement for Raha-brand hats.

PE Uniform for EY / Primary / Secondary

- PE uniform is the Raha PE shirt and shorts or tracksuit bottoms.
- EY and Primary students can wear their PE uniform on days that they have PE.
- Secondary students need to come in uniform and change in school to PE uniform.



Final decisions on what constitutes the proper uniform are at the discretion of the Head of School.
