New Access Control System

From Monday, 22nd September

As part of our ongoing commitment to safeguarding and ensuring the safety of all students, staff, and visitors on campus, we will be activating a new access control system from Monday, 22nd September. This means that certain doors will now only be accessible to staff using their ID cards, with parents/guardians and visitors entering only through our Reception Areas. Please note that parents/guardians will continue to have access at peak times during arrivals and dismissals.

With the school now growing to over 2,000 students, these steps are essential to ensure that movement around the campus is carefully managed and that safeguarding standards remain consistently high.

Parents and visitors should enter the school via Security at:

- Gate 1 for Primary and Secondary
- Gate 2 for EY (Minis, EY1 and EY2)

From there, Security will guide you to the Reception area, where you will be asked to wait until a staff member collects you. During the school day, we kindly ask that parents make appointments in advance if they wish to meet with teachers.

This system has been introduced to strengthen security and to ensure that movement around the school is managed in a safe and consistent way.

For safeguarding reasons, parents and visitors must not use student toilets at any time, even when accompanying their own child. This is especially important during arrivals and dismissals, when large numbers of students are moving around the school. Visitor toilet facilities are available at our Reception Areas if required.

Your children's safety is at the heart of every decision we make. These changes strengthen our safeguarding measures, and we value your patience and support as we put them in place.

Morning Parking at Gate 4/5 Area


We would like to share an update regarding morning traffic in the Gate 4/5 car park area.

We have noticed congestion near Gate 4 as many drivers try to park in the closest parking spots, causing delays that stretch back towards Gate 1 and impacting school buses trying to enter the school. To ease this, we have introduced a new procedure: each morning the first few parking spots near Gate 4 will be temporarily closed, with security guiding parents further into the car park. As the car park fills, these parking spots will be reopened. This trial, has already begun and the improve of traffic flow has been noticeable.

We are also exploring the possibility of adding another "Drop & Go" area in this section, though the layout requires careful consideration. In the meantime, we ask for your cooperation with security staff as they work to keep traffic moving safely.

As parking is limited, we strongly encourage parents who wish to walk their children in to park across the road on the street. Thank you for your patience and support as we trial these measures.
