Dear KCC Families,

It has been an exceptional second week here at Raha International, KCC. We are beginning to settle into our rhythm and routine, thank you to all of our families for your invaluable support currently.

I wanted to share some internal updates as we look ahead to complete this academic year and also ahead to 2026-7.

We have enjoyed our return immensely, students deserve great credit for the way they have arrived back at campus, all statutory risk assessment actions, required drills and training is complete and we are extremely happy to see over 90% of our cohort back to in person learning!

We now are in receipt of the local authority approval regarding significant decisions that will allow KCC to fully be open, in all areas. An example being outdoor play, it's been amazing to see something so simple as play return, we know how important this is too for our children especially after the previous two months away from campus.

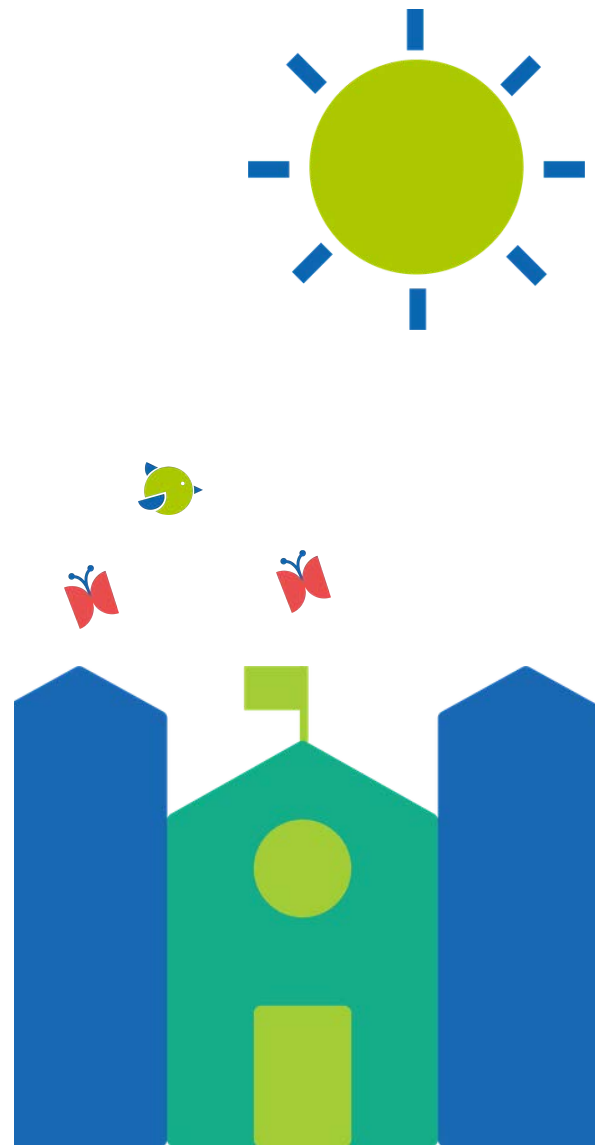

Thank you for your continued support in reinforcing a unified approach to online safety across the UAE, and for helping us create secure, respectful spaces where our students and community can thrive.

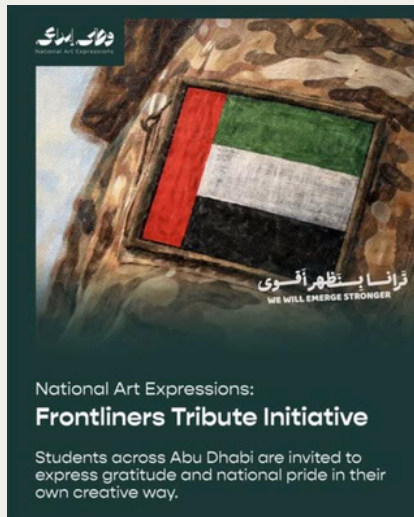

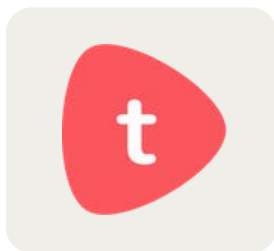
